**Technique:** Beadweaving & Construction Techniques

**Skill Level:** Pattern is written with the beginner in mind, and suitable for all levels.

This pattern is written for learning construction and basic stitching techniques. Bracelet may be strung in a variety of ways to achieve the look, length, and style you like.

**Colorways Available:**

1. Limonchello (Jonquil/Bronze)
2. Chambord (Blackberry/Hematite)
3. Malibu (Blue Turq./Bronze)
4. Blue Curacao (Sapphire/Hematite)5

**Kit Contents:** This is a beginner level project focusing on basic bead stitching, to make seed bead "jackets" that encompass a Czech glass cushion bead. There are 6 Czech glass satellite beads and enough GemDuos and Cushions to make 5 covered beads. String the covered beads in any configuration to create the bracelet, earrings, or necklace you desire.

5 - 14mm. Czech Cushion beads

6 - 8mm Czech Satellite Beads

65 - Czech GemDuo Beads

5g. - 15/o Seed beads

5g. - 8/o Seed beads

4 - 2mm Crimp tubes

2 - 4mm Crimp covers

1 - Matching Toggle Clasp

12 inches beading wire

Printed color instructions with diagrams, photographs, and step-by step details.

Fireline (6lb) or favorite beading thread

Scissors

Crimping Pliers

Cutting Pliers
